



Participants in the first World Rosary Day 2024 are invited to join the Worldpriest Annual Global Rosary Relay for the Sanctification of Priests 2025

In 2024 Catholics had the opportunity to participate in two major prayer events that took place around the world, one in the first half of the year and the other in the second semester.

First the Worldpriest Annual Global Rosary Relay for the Sanctification of Priests took place on the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on 27 June, when seven hundred million Hail Marys were prayed, followed by a very successful collaboration to launch the first World Rosary Day on 7 October, Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary last year.

This year World Rosary Day will again take place on 7 October.
